	<p>Behavioral Health (20 minutes)</p> <p>Adolescent ED survey – summary of results; discuss next steps (Reid & Lisa L)</p> <p>Reid – shared survey and summary of results including potential strategies to address the high number of adolescents presenting in the ED with mental health conditions. See slide for results on potential short term and long-term strategies. Survey was collaborative effort of BH and Community Paramedicine workgroups.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Confirmed moving forward: development of communication materials to assist stakeholders in knowing where resources are, and that telehealth is an option. NETRC tackling this and will help coordinate with School-based TBH pilot as appropriate. <p>LML - In addition to the survey results, did outreach to the larger EDs in the state. Asked them how telehealth could play a role in reducing ED visits for youth with MH diagnoses. A majority of youth coming in have highly complex issues vs. what we initially had anticipated (80/20 mix of less complex vs. more complex). There are a lot of other state efforts to try and better understand kids with more severe diagnoses and prolonged stays. In terms of what could be done, a lot of suggestions line up with survey results. The following were identified as priorities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Increase workforce capacity - leverage telehealth earlier. Maybe look out of state for providers. 2. Communicate crisis and mobile crisis and promote availability - through schools, PCPs. 3. Could there be more offering of more intense treatment options - telehealth through IOP? Availability of higher level BH services? <p>Danielle mentioned current ECHO focused on Peds and Behavioral Health; open to Pediatricians and PCPs. <p>TH/TM Priority Areas</p>	<p>School-based Telebehavioral Health Pilot update (Lisa L)</p> <p>LML - Project Sarah Squirrel started, looking at school health. She identified a model out of MA - Heywood Healthcare - utilized CDC funds to offer BH services in schools in conjunction with a community health worker. Moving this pilot forward in the next month or so. More details to come.</p> <p>Carol - we are hearing from social workers they are doing a lot of resource connecting - CHWs taking this on would be very helpful</p> <p>Support Primary Care (10 minutes) (Andrew, Caren, Danielle) Maine eConsult network implementation; timeline/next steps for pilots Andrew shared background on DHHS Maine eConsult Network: 1-year pilot program to implement and expand the Maine eConsult Network (MEeCN) which was initialized through a HRSA planning grant that was awarded to MCD and NETRC in 2020. Will be conducting outreach to recruit specialists and disseminate application for PCPs. Informational webinars upcoming. Maine Children's Oral Health Network received funds for estimated July 1 project start. Assess, train and implement a specific tele-dentistry platform. Build virtual dental homes in PCP settings. Update: Maine Family Planning got a significant amount of funding Title X to expand telehealth for reproductive health</p> <p>Connectivity/Broadband Expansion (10 minutes) (Danielle & Reid)</p> <p>Maine Connectivity Authority and ConnectMaine updates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2022 Broadband Awards – Eight awards across Maine communities totaling over \$15M; awarded through ConnectMaine annual process with additional funds from MCA. - NTIA request for proposals is now open – this is the next large chunk of funds MCA will be submitting for, specifically the Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment (BEAD) program - Maine Connectivity Authority has started to hire staff with two openings still posted. See website: www.maineconnectivity.org - Other MCA initiatives in progress: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Workplan submitted to federal Capital Projects Fund for \$128 million in Maine; o Middle Mile Survey now live - strong part of strategy is to create competition and remove barriers o MCA is launching the Jumpstart Connectivity Initiative (Jumpstart) to provide accelerated low-cost internet access to the least served areas of the state by trialing the deployment of wireless technology deployments; to provide funding for between 1 and 4 pilot projects with a total budget of up to \$2M.
