We are looking at out of state pharm groups but the current bill does not allow for remote prescribing.</p> <p>Yvonne – what is allowable for out of state licensure, other than social workers? Danielle/Reid – we are part of multiple interstate compacts, Maine is already participating in some of the older compacts, the Social Work compact is somewhat new. Andrew shared Audiology Compact as an exapmle.</p> <p>Dr. Ross – based on clinical practice, b/c various compacts are variable and require detailed understanding, the majority of legal advice to providers is to provide in state only. This limits ability to take care of anyone outside of state border. Not really a problem solver – administrative nightmare.</p> <p>LML – Even if someone gets licensed in Maine, under current MaineCare laws you cannot be a MaineCare provider unless you are physically in Maine or within 15 miles of the border.</p> <p>Henry – a provider can enroll with a physical site and then have other out of state providers, but physical presence must be in Maine or within 15 miles of Maine-NH border.</p> <p>Dr. Ross – eConsults – they don’t require state licensure or credentialing as the responsibility for the patient remains with the primary care provider.
