



Pilot Program Update

February 2, 2023

- **With funding from Maine DHHS, MCD Global Health is facilitating a one-year pilot program to implement and evaluate eConsults.**
- eConsults are **timely communications hosted on a secure electronic platform that occur asynchronously** (at different times) between primary care providers (PCPs), or other healthcare professionals, and specialist providers.
- MEeCN is using the **ConferMED** eConsult platform and their existing specialty network (all consulting providers are licensed in Maine) while we also recruit additional, local specialists.
- Our first eConsult was submitted December 2022 (see next slide).
- We will be evaluating the program with support of the **Maine Rural Health Research Center** and will develop a sustainability plan.





