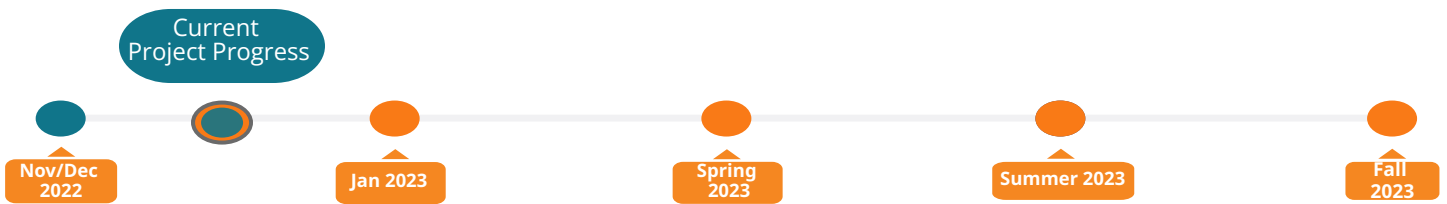




ME PNMI Telehealth Capacity Expansion Pilot

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Maine's Office for Medicaid Services (MaineCare) is working with MCD Global Health and the Northeast Telehealth Resource Center to improve access to healthcare services within Maine's Private Non-Medical Institutions (PNMIs) through expanded utilization of telehealth. **We'd love to work with your organization to add or expand telehealth services based on the needs of your residents!**



GOAL 1

Assess Current Telehealth Landscape

- ✓ Survey All PNMI's in ME to assess interest and capacity to participate
- ✓ Identify 70 facilities to complete in-depth assessment
- ★ Conduct assessments with individual facilities to understand technology infrastructure, staffing capacity & patient needs
- Identify 35 facilities to participate in Year 1 Pilot Telehealth Expansion

GOAL 2

Expand Telehealth Capacity

- MCD Global Health (MCD) meets with individual facilities to develop expansion plan
- MCD procures telehealth technology set-ups
- PNMI facility installs telehealth equipment, with assistance from MCD as needed
- MCD provides training and technical assistance to sites as requested (e.g. tech, room setup, telehealth etiquette, workflows, etc.)

GOAL 3

Improve Health Access and Outcomes

- MCD and Maine DHHS identify providers to support telehealth offerings to PNMI sites
- Year 1 Pilot Sites and MCD collaboratively develop resources for future site expansion
- MCD and ME DHHS identify facilities for Year 2 effort
